Dr Arnaud Gagneur obtained his degree in Paediatric medicine at the University of Brest (France) in 1999. He then specialised in neonatology, paediatric infectiology and vaccinology. His research training began in 1998 with a master's degree in microbiology (Rennes) and he obtained a PhD in virology in 2007 (Brest). He practised medicine in the Paediatric and Neonatal Intensive Care Unit of the Brest University Hospital centre from 2001 to 2008. In May 2008, Professor Arnaud Gagneur joined the Paediatric Department of the University of Sherbrooke in Canada. His present research focuses on the epidemiological impact of different vaccines, including rotavirus. Professor Arnaud Gagneur conducted important studies which investigated the effectiveness of rotavirus vaccination in real-life settings. His current projects in Quebec, Canada target rotavirus and pneumococcal vaccination. He conducted a public health grant program about promoting vaccination in nurseries.
